

The best bathing spots in and around Lucerne



Swimming, cooling off, relaxing and enjoying a bite to eat:

Lake Lucerne offers all this and more.

1 Ufschötti

The Ufschötti lakeside park is a 10-minute walk away through the station and past the shipyard of the Lake Lucerne Navigation Company (SGV).

2 Tribschenbadi

Situated downhill from the Richard Wagner Museum, the Tribschenbadi bathing spot is a 25-minute walk from the hotel, or hop on bus 6, 7 or 8 and alight at „Wartegg“.

3 St. Niklausen


St. Niklausen offers glorious views of the region and the lake. To get there, take bus 21 and alight at „St. Niklausen“. Sad to say, the Hotel St. Niklausen is closed, and has been for many years.

4 Chrämerstein

The lake at Villa Chrämerstein makes for a wonderfully romantic bathing spot. Take bus 21 there and alight at „Krämerstein“.

5 Kastanienbaum

To reach Kastanienbaum, take bus 21 and alight at „Kastanienbaum“. Admire the scenic beauties of the area from the terrace of the Hotel Kastanienbaum.



6 Seeforschungslaboratorium

To get to the bathing spot by this lake research institute, hop on bus 21 and alight at „Kastanienbaum“; it's then a 15-minute walk along the lakeside road. Alternatively, it's a 25–30 minute bike ride from the hotel. This idyllic spot is great for children.

7 Rüteli

This spot is 10 minutes beyond the Seeforschungslaboratorium (6) along the lakeside road – or a 30-minute cycle from the hotel.

8 Winkelbadi Horw

The small yet lovely Winkelbadi bathing spot can be cycled to in 25 minutes, or take bus 20 to „Horw Rank“ and walk for 15 minutes. The restaurant here is highly recommended.

9 Horwerbadi

To get here, hop on bus 20 and alight at „Horw Werkhof“ or enjoy the 25-minute cycle ride from the hotel. The bathing spot is idyllically situated on the Horw Delta and has a kiosk serving snacks and refreshments.

10 Badi Meggen

Take bus 24 from Lucerne railway station to „Meggen, Kapelle“. Then follow Benzholzstrasse past the chapel and take the pedestrian underpass at the station. Head for the lake for a further 10 minutes. Alternatively, it's a 30-minute cycle ride from the hotel.

11 Seeburg

Bus 24 to „Hotel Seeburg“ or cycle there from the hotel in 15 minutes. The lakeside grounds of the Hotel Seeburg are a delight.

12 Lido Luzern

Lucerne's own lido is the largest such amenity in the region. You can get there by catching buses 6, 8 or 24 to „Verkehrshaus“, or it's a 10-minute cycle ride from the hotel.

13 Bühlermatte

This spot right in front of the Swiss Museum of Transport benefits from magnificent trees and splendid views of Lucerne. Bus 6, 8 or 24 to „Verkehrshaus“ or cycle there from the hotel in 10 minutes.

14 Seebad Luzern

Possibly the loveliest lido of all! Just right for city lovers with a sense of nostalgia. It's a 15-minute walk or a 5-minute cycle from the hotel.



Top tips
